AUTOBODY & COLLISION REPAIR TECHNICIAN EXEMPTION TEST NOW AVAILABLE ACROSS ONTARIO

Always wanted to be a collision repair technician?

You might have some work experience or have partial training time and felt that full-time

apprenticeship was not needed or you completed your high school autobody class using the new apprenticeship curriculum that is offered by some school boards?

Starting January 2018, any individual with autobody skills can write the Level 1 exemption exam at any community college in the province. This way, the applicant will be able to determine the level of their skills, be possibly exempted from Level 1 training, starting then at Level 2 apprenticeship in school and be able to work legally, faster in the trade.
