ORDER

PURSUANT TO AN ORDER dated September 18, 2017, this matter was heard by a panel of the Discipline Committee and determined on October 23, 2017, pursuant to section 46(1)(a) of the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act (the "Act");

UPON CONSIDERING the Member's admission to the allegations, an Agreed Statement of Fact, a Joint Submission on Penalty and Costs, submissions of Counsel for the Ontario College of Trades (the "College"), and those of the Member;

THIS PANEL OF THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE, pursuant to section 46(2) of the Act, found the Member guilty of professional misconduct as set out in allegations (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) of the Notice of Hearing issued January 17, 2017; and as a result, Page 2 of 2

THIS PANEL OF THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE made the following orders:

1. The Member shall pay a fine in the amount of \$2,000 to the Minister of Finance within 12 months of the date of this Order, pursuant to section 46(5)2 of the Act;
2. The Registrar is directed to revoke the Member's certificate of qualification in the trade of Auto Body and Collision Damage Repairer (310B), Journeyperson class, effective on the date of this Order, pursuant to section 46(4)1 of the Act;
3. The Member shall not apply to the Registrar under Part VI of the Act to have a new certificate of qualification issued for a period of 12 months from the date of this Order, pursuant to section 46(7) of the Act;

4. The finding and the order of the Panel shall be published in summary with the name of the Member and the name and address of the Member's business in the official publication of the College and on the website of the College, pursuant to section 46(5)3 of the Act; and

5. The Member shall pay costs to the College in the amount of \$3,000 within 12 months of the date of this Order, pursuant to section 46(5)4 of the Act.
